Emergency: An Oregon native, Leon*, went on vacation with his family to Nevada. When they arrived to enjoy the Silver State's scenic mountain top views, Leon, his younger brother and aunt fell off the side of the peak during a hiking tour. All three family members were rushed to the nearest hospital. Leon sustained broken bones and a concussion. Leon underwent several surgeries and was stabilized. His father, Nathaniel* immediately flew to be at his bedside to help him recover. Nathaniel was informed by the attending physician that his son would require in-patient rehabilitation. During their family's tragic circumstance, Nathaniel contacted Assist America to have Leon brought back home for rehabilitation.

Response: When heartbreaking incidents occur, Assist America will take the burden off our members' shoulders during their time of need. Our team was swift to respond to Nathaniel's call and we began our medical monitoring service to ensure Leon was receiving appropriate care. Assist America's Operations Case Managers also maintained communication with Nathaniel and his treatment staff throughout the medical emergency. TAG YOUR BAG

After a long holiday flight, you are excited to reach your destination. While you walk to baggage claim to pick up your luggage, you think about the plans you have set out for the next few days. It may be a nice dinner with family and friends, a concert, or even a professional sports exhibtion. Whatever plans you have for the trip, you are excited and ready to leave the airport. As you wait for your bags, you notice everyone else picking up their bags. Then, the baggage carousel rotates continuously and your bags are nowhere to be found. That feeling of the unknown sets in and you realize your bags didn't arrive at your final destination.

Remain calm and contact Assist America to help you file your lost or delayed baggage report with your airline. Assist America recommends that before you leave for your trip, always remember to tag it with your name and contact information. Many travelers are now taking a picture of their luggage so they can identify and describe it to a baggage agent at the airport. Filing a report allows you to obtain a tracking number which is helpful to locate your lost luggage with the airline.

After you file a claim for your lost/delayed baggage, ask to see if you are able to receive any compensation. The compensation varies for each airline. Most airlines are required to compensate travelers for incidental expenses that may occur while bags are not in their possession. For example, if you checked in items that are essential for your trip, such as toiletries and business meeting attire, you may be entitled to compensation. The traveler should ask the airline for their lost/delayed luggage policy before leaving the airport.

Though Assist America specializes in providing medical emergency assistance, we also provide travel assistance services, so if your bags do not arrive at your final destination, file a report with your carrier immediately. After you file a claim at the airport, call or email Assist America to track your luggage and get it delivered to your destination. Pack your prescriptions

Nothing replaces the real thing!

With all of the preparation of packing clothes to stuffing your electronics in your carry-on, to the toiletries in your extra luggage, everything is set to go, right? But the one essential many travelers should not go without are their daily supplements and of course, prescription medications. It's another checklist burden for many, but it's well worth preserving your health and well-being! Before you travel, take control of your trip and:



Pack an additional dosage to cover any travel delays, as replacing prescriptions abroad may be difficult, particularly in a short timeframe. The needed medication may be unavailable or of limited quantity.



Check your local embassy or diplomatic mission to see whether medications may be prohibited from entering their destination country. Prescription certification for some drugs can sometimes take several weeks and be a very complex procedure. To avoid delay, leave plenty of time before departure to obtain the required certification.



Pack all medications in a carry-on luggage with their originally labeled containers and written prescriptions to minimize delays with customs officials. In addition, if carrying specifically restricted items onto aircraft, such as hypodermic syringes, you should notify customs and security officials. Carry a note from your prescribing physician on letterhead stationery for any controlled substances and injectable medications.

A counterfeit will NOT work towards your benefit!

<u>DID YOU KNOW</u>: The World Health Organization estimates that 10-30 percent of medicines sold in developing countries may be counterfeit, with some studies concluding that the proportion may be even higher. The problem appears to be far less common in the developed world, including the U.S., Australia, Japan, Canada, New Zealand, and Western Europe, where estimates suggest less than 1 percent of medicines sold are counterfeit.*

Substandard drugs are common in developing countries and countries with few or no rules against making or distributing counterfeit medications.

While laboratory analysis is the only reliable way to determine whether a drug is counterfeit, there are some telltale signs to be aware of:



The drug has a strange or unfamiliar smell, taste, or color.



Pills or tablets break apart easily.



The packaging is of poor quality, or there are apparent problems with the labeling, such as misspelled words.



. The prescription costs very little, compared with the regular price of that particular medication.

Traveling with Diabetes or a Physical Disability

Members can be exposed to many factors that can impact their health and wellbeing. While most travelers will not experience any health difficulties, long journeys can affect those with underlying health conditions. People with chronic conditions should ensure they are in good health before flying, and should also have a pre-travel consultation with their doctor several weeks before travel. If you are diabetic:



Consult with your Doctor

Share your travel itinerary with your doctor. Do not change your overall routine unless otherwise instructed by your physician.



Know Where You Are

Adjust your insulin schedule if changing timezones, particularly if crossing more than three to five timezones. Insulin-dependent travelers should check their blood sugar upon arrival in case of disruption of schdeuled dosage.



Do Your Homework

Familiarize with the state of health infrastructure at your destination. Insulin-dependent travelers should research what insulin type and concentration is standard in their destination country, along with the quality and location of local hospitals. Have a contingency plan in place should you require additional stocks of insulin or other medical supplies.

If you have a disability:



Seek Accommodations

Some countries are not adequately equipped for people with disabilities and makes travel more difficult. Inform your travel agency ahead of time regarding the nature of your disability. Over the past few years, more and more tour operators have modified their offerings to better accommodate those with a disability - some tour operators now focus on accessible travel.



Research Transportation Vendors

Inquire about general transport infrastructure and other services that will be available and choose the operator that they feel will work best for your needs.



Know What Services are Available

If traveling by air, you should inquire what kind of assistance is in place at the airports you will be flying through, along with the airline's policies related to your condition, including crutches, canes, and splints.

- Travel with a companion. If traveling alone, make sure you're prepared to handle any health-related eventualities or accessibility challenges that may arise.
- Pack additional the medication you may need during their trip to cover unexpected travel delays, damages, and losses. To avoid complications at customs, as well as to aid local doctors, keep your medications in their original packaging and carry a copy of your prescription.
- Contact your health insurance provider prior to traveling to understand how out-of-country claims are handled. Be prepared to handle medical expenses.
