Recognized by the American College of Surgeons' Commission on Cancer, the NorthBay Cancer Center supports patients every step of the way in their cancer journey, from diagnosis and surgery to ongoing treatment and recovery. In the most complex cases, our physicians can reach out to Mayo Clinic colleagues for a second opinion on treatment plans.

Cardiovascular Care

The NorthBay Heart and Vascular Center is the only comprehensive center for advanced cardiovascular services in Solano County. NorthBay Medical Center operates Solano's first accredited Chest Pain Center, as well as provides PCI (balloon angioplasty) and open-heart surgery. The latest techniques offered in a state-of-the-art operating suite include coronary artery bypass, valve repair, valve replacement and TAVR. Our team of cardiovascular experts are trained in minimally invasive techniques used to treat a variety of vascular diseases—without open surgery. This means less pain and a faster, easier recovery for patients.

Emergency Care

No one plans for an emergency, but if one happens, NorthBay's Emergency Department experts are ready to help with 24/7/365 service at NorthBay Medical Center in Fairfield and NorthBay VacaValley Hospital in Vacaville. NorthBay Medical Center is certified as a Level II Trauma Center by the American College of Surgeons.
